VETYVER OIL: : Local production costs continue to increase. Export demand for this time of the year has been steady. Most distilleries have been producing at a reduced rate. Prices of the oil have remained firm. We are approaching the rainy season, at which time the digging of roots for distillation becomes sporadic and difficult. Unsold inventories are modest. We have stock and invite your inquiries.

AMYRIS OIL: The market remains relatively stable. Supply seems a little tighter than usual. Export demand has been active. At this time, we do NOT expect any significant movement in price (up/down) for the foreseeable future. As always, this could change suddenly/unexpectedly with any major change in supply/demand. We have stock and invite your inquiries.

Our oils are all natural, pure – as distilled – NOT assembled/manipulated/adjusted.

HONDURAS

CARDAMOM OIL: We are producing as we receive orders. There is no stock for immediate deliveries. For this oil, we solicit your inquiries.

STYRAX GUM AND OIL: Volume of sales has been moderate, prices are steady and on the low side. Inventories of the crude gum are sufficient to produce the Purified Gum, as well as Oil 645P, to meet demand. Your inquiries for both the Purified Gum and the Oil are invited.
