VETYVER OIL: The distillation/production cycle has resumed after the usual year-end termination of the rainy season. Oil yields are normal and root harvesting is facilitated due to longer dry periods. Export sales have continued at a steady pace. The usual upsurge of export demand has leveled off. Export prices have been steady to slightly downward. Inventories in the hands of non-exporting distillers are fair to moderate. We look forward to your inquires and requests for samples.

AMYRIS OIL: Export demand as well as production continues at a steady pace. Prices are well maintained, qualities are good and stocks are sufficient for present demands. We look forward to your inquires and requests for samples.

HONDURAS

CARDAMOM OIL: Although there have been some sales, the market has decreased substantially. We have slowed production until a better feel for the direction of the market can be determined. We have limited stock available. We welcome your inquiries.

STYRAX GUM AND OIL: Export demand has slowed somewhat during the last months. Export prices for both the Purified Gum and the Oil 645P are steady and if dropped to any extent, the incentive to tap trees and collect the crude product during the current collecting period will become nil. At this time we hold some limited stock of Crude Gum, which we can purify or distill to produce our Oil 645P to meet demand. We solicit your inquiries.
